

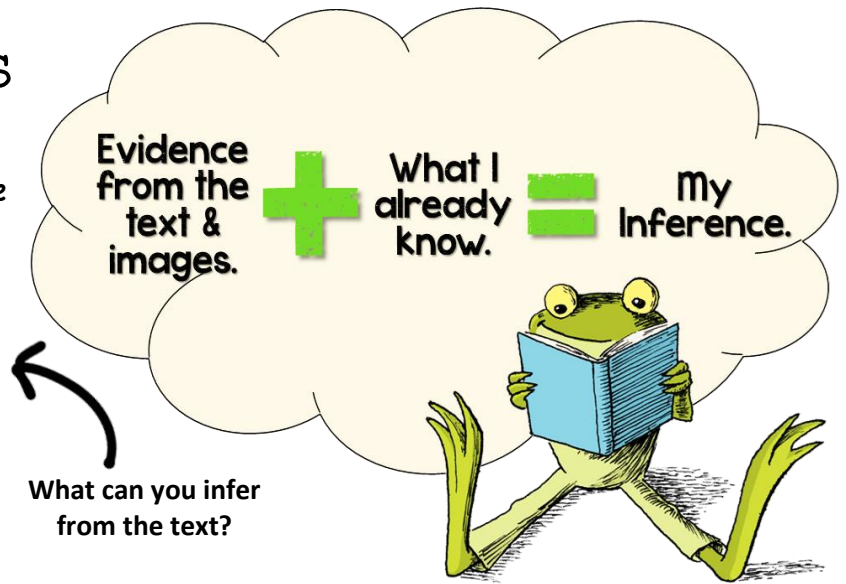
Make Inferences

when you read

inference: Using text and pictures (**evidence**) combined with what you already know (**reasoning**) to figure out what the story is about.

Read Between the Lines

Auggie stomped through the front door after school and tossed his book bag on the floor. He ran up the stairs to his bedroom and slammed his bedroom door. Auggie flung himself on the bed and put his pillow over his head. He was never going to talk to Jack again!



SUMmarize It!

Shorter than the text

Use your own words

Main ideas only



Summarizing

A good **summary** is a much shorter version of a story, text, or event... yet it includes the most important details.
(SWBS)

You can quickly find the most important parts by answering these questions...

- ★ **SOMEBODY:** Who is the main character?
- ★ **WANTED:** What did the main character want?
- ★ **BUT:** What was the problem?
- ★ **SO:** How did the character solve the problem?
