characters

the **individuals** that the story is about.

setting

where and **when** the story takes place.

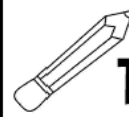
conflict

a **problem** that is faced by the characters.

theme

an underlying **message, lesson,** or the **big idea.**

NARRATIVE TRANSITIONS

TRANSITIONS ARE USED TO SHOW CHANGE TO A NEW PLACE OR NEW EVENT IN A STORY.

As soon as

Initially

It started

At first

Late or later

On [day]

Moments later

Later on

In an instant

In just minutes

By the time
